Time is Running Out

February 23, 2012 – Time is running out for defendants to voluntarily dispose of their warrants before arrests begin on Saturday, February 25, 2012 in the Great Texas Warrant Round Up.

Individuals with outstanding warrants are subject to arrest at any time and location, including their home, work or in public. To avoid the inconvenience and embarrassment of arrest, defendants need to voluntarily dispose of their case before Saturday, February 25.

A \$50 warrant fee will be waived for any defendant who voluntarily appears in Municipal Court to settle their warrant before Saturday, February 25.

Cash, check, money order, or credit card (MasterCard, Visa and Discover) payments are accepted online at trafficpayment.com or by calling 800.444.1187 or 888.444.1187. Defendants can visit Odessa Municipal Court, 201 North Grant, until 6 p.m. today through Friday, March 4, 2011.

Warrants will remain in effect until payment is received and posted by Municipal Court.

Warrants are a result of an individual's failure to appear in person, or in writing, at Odessa Municipal Court, or failure to comply with a court order. Citations that are handled through Odessa Municipal Court, and that could be part of the roundup, include traffic, parking tickets, code enforcement violations, failure to sterilize a pet adopted from the Odessa Animal Shelter, and other violations of the Odessa Municipal code or state law.

Anyone unsure if they have a warrant is encouraged to log on to the City of Odessa's website, odessa-tx.gov, for a complete list of individuals with warrants.
